Col Schiefer,  
In the email below, AF/DPPR indicates the POM initiative to fund the human resources research database is approved and they need a firm decision on whether AFPC will accept the database. Please confirm that, based on our earlier communications, AFPC will take the database given the following resources: funding for four positions (see note below), including 1 database administrator and 3 programmers, \$55K/yr for hardware/software/supplies, and the database associated computer equipment/software currently at Brooks AFB.

Note: The initial database POM initiative estimate of 7 positions was based on the number of people supporting the database during FY97. The chief of the database section at Brooks, SSgt Martinez, indicates 4 people will be required to maintain the database under the conditions anticipated when DP accepts the database. The reduction in number of personnel required is based on several factors, including the transferring the data from tape to optical disk, the reduced programmer support required when the data are converted to an Oracle database format, and reduced access requirements.
