Dear Jimmie:

I have packed up the stuff on job analysis, in five boxes, ready for shipment. I should add a few comments about the accumulation.

I had accumulated the materials over several years, prior to my retirement in 1977. It includes a lot of what(now) might be called junk, but at the same time there are items in the batch that may still have relevance, and possibly historical value. Some of the reports are going "back home" since they came from Lackland AFB.

They are in somewhat numerical order, but, but only "approximate" order. There are some at the end (in box 5) that I found after I had packed the others, so they are definitely out of order. There also are a few un-numbered items at the end.

At the end is a copy of the complete list (including two supplements). The "format" of the listings is very inconsistent, since the items were typed at different times, by different secretaries. They are generally in alphabetical order--but with a few exceptions--by authors' names. Such an ordering, however, resulted in certain series of reports being scattered throughout the list, rather than being grouped together. I am also enclosing in box 5 the index cards. (I have a hunch that the cards and the list do not jibe in all respects, and there may be a few missing items that have evaporated over the years.

I apologize for the format of the listing, and for the lack of perfect numerical order of the items. However, I am very pleased that the stuff will have a home, and I hope it may be of some use to you and the AF.

In connection with the pick-up of the boxes, although we usually are here, it might be well for the "picker-uppers" to call before they come. 463-5996.
